



**CRITERIA TO MEASURE BRACELET SIZE**

1. This is a chart that will be extremely helpful for you to determine the bracelet size that you need. Measure your hand, you will need a measuring tape or a piece of paper and a ruler. Bring your thumb and little finger together and measure where your hand is the widest as shown in the picture.

**1 Step**

- Cut a thin strip of paper or thread
- Bring your thumb and little finger together
- Wrap where Your hand is the Widest.
- Mark the spot where the paper/Thread Meets

**Step 2**

- Measure the length of the thread with your ruler
- Use the Following chart to determine your Bracelet size.

2. Here is another chart that can also be considered in determining the appropriate bracelet size. Measure the inside diameter of a bracelet that you already own. It measures inside the diameter of such bracelet in millimeters. This is normally used for double checking your results from the usual paper method. Apart from this, you can also make use of the bracelet that you wear daily and cross check the same with below chart.

**1 Step**

- Take a bracelet you already own place it on a scale
- Measure the inner diameter
- Use following chart to determine your ring size
